Use the following critical thinking questions to help foster an open, student-led discussion on the theme(s) discussed in this episode of The Harbor.

- 1. LIKE MANY OF US, QUINCY WAS HESITANT TO PURSUE HIS PASSIONS BECAUSE HE WAS
“. . . SCARED OF BEING LAUGHED AT.**

When have you felt this way? Did you let this fear stop you from doing what you wanted to do?

What advice from Quincy can you use to help you move past this fear in the future?

- 2. QUINCY BELIEVES THAT, “YOU’RE NOT PUT ON THIS WORLD TO DO EVERYTHING BY YOURSELF.” WITH THE HELP
OF HIS GRANDMOTHER, HE WAS ABLE TO TAKE VOCAL LESSONS AND START PURSUING MUSIC MORE SERIOUSLY.**

Who supports you or pushes you to work harder in and/or outside of school? Name three people who support you and write them a note of gratitude.

ACROSS THE WORLD “. . . THAT ARE TRYING TO DO THE SAME THING THAT YOU’RE DOING.”**
